

Professor Jozef Nosek was born on May 17, 1967 in Bratislava (Czechoslovakia). He is an eminent scholar in the field of yeast genetics, currently Professor of Biochemistry at Comenius University in Bratislava, Faculty of Natural Sciences, Department of Biochemistry, Bratislava, Slovak Republic. He's career is associated with the Comenius University in Bratislava, where he received MSc in Genetics and Molecular Biology (Supervisor: Prof. Ladislav Kovac) in 1990, and PhD in Genetics (Supervisor: Prof. Ladislav Kovac) in 1994. He obtained DSc in Molecular Biology in 2006.

He obtained several research fellowships abroad (Institute Curie, Orsay, France; Institute of Microbiology and Genetics, University of Paris XI, Orsay, France; EMBO Fellowship; Postdoctoral Fellowship, Ministry of Education and Research of the French Government) and scientific awards (Medal of the Faculty of Natural Sciences, Comenius University in Bratislava; Plaque of Appreciation from the Philippine Society for Microbiology Inc.; 2006-2010 Howard Hughes Medical Institute International Research Scholar; Outstanding Junior Scientist Award of the Faculty of Natural Sciences, Comenius University in Bratislava; Award of the Czechoslovak Microbiological Society for Junior Czech and Slovak Microbiologist; Junior Researcher of the Year 1999 in the Slovak Republic; Medal of the President of the Comenius University in Bratislava for Excellent Study Achievements).

He is member of the Slovak Academic Society (SAS), the scientific board of the Faculty of Natural Sciences, Comenius University, Bratislava; the Genetic Society of America; the Gregor Mendel Genetic Society; the Czechoslovak Society for Microbiology.

His publication list comprises co authorship of 1 monographs and 3 book chapters; 14 review and opinion articles, 5 commentaries / editorials, 59 original research papers, 6 articles in conference proceedings, 5 books and textbooks in Slovak, and a laboratory manual in Slovak.
